Sports at NMIMS Hyderabad

The Academic Year 2025-2026 witnessed the highest number of sports events conducted for both students and faculty at NMIMS Hyderabad. A wide range of sporting activities were organized by the Sports Department in collaboration with various Sports Committees, ensuring active participation and engagement across the campus.

All major occasions related to sports were celebrated with great enthusiasm. The year began with the celebration of International Yoga Day, followed by International Volleyball Day and National Sports Day. On these occasions, separate sports events were organized for students and faculty members.

An Ice-Breaking Event was conducted for first-year students, featuring recreational activities aimed at helping them become familiar with the sports culture on campus and encouraging their interest in sports from the beginning.

Several flagship events were successfully organized by the five Sports Committees, including Net & Knights, NMPL 8.0, Khelo NMIMS, Chakravyuh, and NMCL. Additionally, new initiatives were introduced this year, such as the inter-school sports event "PRAHAAR 2026" and the first-ever UG-LIGA football tournament for students.

Numerous sporting activities were also conducted for staff and faculty members, including Carrom Masters, events on International Volleyball Day and National Sports Day, the Sports Fest, and Teachers' Day celebrations.

Sports at NMIMS Hyderabad

In total, approximately 36-40 sports events were organized within the campus. NMIMS Hyderabad hosted the Inter-NMIMS Campus Basketball Tournament, where the girls' team secured third place.

Furthermore, NMIMS students represented the university at the West Zone Inter-University Sports Events in basketball (women), cricket, and volleyball (men).

Students were recognized and rewarded with trophies, medals, and certificates for their efforts and achievements.
